We are seeking a Digital Skills Trainer to join our team on a 3 months contract (renewable). The Digital Skills Trainer will be responsible for developing and delivering training programs that enhance the digital literacy of individuals and communities. The Trainer will design and implement digital skills training sessions, workshops, and other capacity building initiatives to empower beneficiaries with knowledge and practical skills to thrive in the digital age. The Trainer will work with individuals from diverse backgrounds and must have a passion for helping others learn, grow and improve their digital literacy.

Responsibilities

- Design and deliver digital skills training programs to individuals and communities, covering a range of topics such as basic computer literacy, online safety, social media, e-commerce, digital marketing, graphic design and website development.
- Conduct training needs assessments to identify the digital skills gaps and develop customized training solutions to address them.
- Develop training materials and resources, including manuals, handouts, presentations, and online learning modules, to support the delivery of training programs.

- Deliver training sessions in person using a variety of teaching methods to engage learners and promote active participation.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of training programs, gather feedback from learners, and adjust training materials and delivery methods accordingly.
